FISHERIES ACT NUMBER 8 OF 1988

Fishing Regulation

(UNDER SECTION 32)

By the power conferred upon under the Section 32 of the Fisheries Act Number. 8 of 1988, the Minister of Agriculture, Livestock and Natural Resources is happy to make the following regulations (as attached here in).



	1. These Regulations may be cited as a main principle of Fisheries of 1993 and shall become effective beginning on July 1, 1993.	Name of Rules and entry into force
	2. " Underwater Fishing (hunting)" means fishing for sport or other kind of fun (Leisure) but not for economic activity.	Definitions
Validity of the License	22. (1) Any license issued under the authority of these Regulations is for all types of licenses with the exception of;	
	(a) License for Underwater Fishing (hunting) mentioned in part (2) of these Regulations;	
	(b) Specific license issued by the Director by authority of Regulation 21 of these Regulations; if not revoked early then it will continue to be valid until the 31 st of December following the date of issue of the license.	
	(2) Licenses for Underwater Fishing (hunting) may be issued to be used for two weeks or a month or three months or one year, and such kind of license, unless it is invalidated earlier, it can be used as follows:	
	(a) If a license is for two weeks, then for a period of two weeks from the date issued.	
	(b) If a license is for one month, then for a period of one month from the date issued, and	
	(c) If the license is for one year, then it is for a period of one year from the date issued.	
	(d) Any license issued pursuant to these regulations cannot be accepted.	
	37. It is prohibited for any fisherman to travel to camping sites from the:	Prohibition of going to fishing
	(a) Part of the islands of Unguja and Pemba to other parts of that island, or	camping sites without permission
	(b) One island to the other island of Unguja and Pemba, or	
	(c) The islands of Unguja and Pemba to Tanzanian mainland, or

	(d) Tanzania Mainland to come to any part of the islands of Unguja and Pemba, without prior written permission in writing from the Licensing Officer.	
Prohibited use of certain types of spears	48. Unless there are provisions in these Regulations hat say otherwise, it is prohibited for anyone to use, for fishing activities, any of the following equipments:-	

- (a) A gun or guns or similar tools used for fishing activities unless that person is allowed to use such tools with the authority of any other Regulation set out in accordance with the provisions of the Fisheries Act.
- (b) Nets which are in professional language are said to be "*Monofilament*" in fishing place.
