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
**RE: APPROVAL FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF  
RECREATIONAL SPORT SPEARFISHING IN ZANZIBAR.**

With honours please refer to the above mentioned subject.

The Commission for Tourism is pleased to inform you that approval is granted for Open Water Extreme Adventure Ltd. to run the Recreational Sport Spear fishing activities in Zanzibar with the following conditions of which failure to observe, the Commission retains the right to revoke its approval:-

1. That the company should be established and registered in Zanzibar.
2. The project's Certificate is neither for sale nor transferred without permission of the Commission.
3. That the project should contact Zanzibar Revenue Board and Tanzania Revenue Authority (Zanzibar) for their formalities.
4. That the name of the Company should be clearly displayed in front of the main entrance.
5. That the project should submit quarterly progress report punctually to the Commission for Tourism from the date of this approval.
6. That the project should collect its annual business license from Zanzibar Commission for Tourism.

7. That any information concerning the project, its overall operation, recruitment, and any other information needed should be made available to the Commission for Tourism and concerned Government organs.
8. That the project should obey the existing laws, regulations and rules governing tourism and others as may be instructed by the Government.
9. The project should have accounts with any Bank established in Zanzibar.
10. The project shall submit to Commission for Tourism all information of manpower resources development to train Zanzibari's to manage specialized technical work and senior positions.
11. That the project will neither recruit nor involve any foreigner without prior information and approval of the Commission for Tourism.
12. That the application for the work/residence permits for foreign employees shall be done before their arrival into the country.
13. That you will allow officers as may be notified to you to inspect among other thing:
  - Working premises
  - Equipments including motor Vehicles, office machinery, etc.
  - Record Books (guest register, books of accounts, receipts) and any other principal documents that may be required from time to time for inspection.
14. The company should operate separately to other operational base of the company outside Zanzibar which will demarcate the transparency in both accounting system and other related operational issues.
